


# 1. Connection

- 1** Connect the external antennas  
(required for both Wi-Fi and Bluetooth)




- 2** Connect the left and right speakers



- 3** Connect the power cord from the DRA-100  
to a power outlet

- 4** Insert the batteries  
into the remote



# 2. Connecting to your home network



1 Power on




2 Select language



3 Make sure your iOS device is connected to your WiFi Network. Select the network named "Denon DRA-100" from the Settings/Wi-Fi screen on your device



3 Make sure your iOS device is connected to your WiFi Network. Connect your iOS device to the front using your USB cable.



3 Select "Wi-Fi - scan" and wait as your DRA-100 looks for available networks



3 Press the WPS button on your router



## Wired

- 1 Connect a network cable between your DRA-100 and your router (cable not included)



- 2 Power on
- 3 Select language
- 4 Please wait while your DRA-100 connects to your wired network.

- 4 Follow the instructions and tap Next



- 5 Please wait as completing the connection can take a few minutes  
The front panel of the DRA-100 will show the status of the connection



- 4 Press the iOS Button on the back of your DRA-100



- 5 This message will appear on your iOS device  
Select "Allow"


- 4 Select your network name.  
If your network name is not listed, select "Rescan"




- 5 Enter your network password using the number keys on the remote control




- 4 Within 2 minutes, press the WPS button on the back of your DRA-100




- 5 Please wait as completing the connection can take a few minutes  
The front panel of the DRA-100 will show the status of the connection



## Network Control Setting



Select Network Control ON to control DRA-100 from your smartphone, use Bluetooth/NFC/Apple AirPlay® and maintain constant network access. Power Consumption during standby power will be slightly higher.



Select Network Control OFF to reduce power consumption during standby. You can not turn on your DRA-100 from your smartphone or use Bluetooth/NFC/Apple AirPlay until your DRA-100 is powered on manually and connects to your network.




## Enjoying music using Bluetooth

- 1 Press the source button to select Bluetooth, then press and hold the Source button until [Pairing Mode] is displayed



- 3 Select "Denon DRA-100" from the Bluetooth device list on your mobile device

Some devices may require you to verify the numeric code and press ENTER on the DRA-100



- 2 Activate Bluetooth on your mobile device



- 4 Play music using any app on your device



To reconnect a previously paired Bluetooth device, start at step 2.



Pair and connect your NFC capable device by gently touching it on the NFC logo on the front of DRA-100

### Basic trouble shooting

No sound:

- Check all connections.
- Make sure the bare metal wire ends of the speaker wires are in contact with the metal part of the speaker terminals.
